Code of Conduct Handbook

Code of Conduct for the Students:

- Each student is required to adhere to a standard of cleanliness and decency in their attire.
- Every student must carry their identity card at all times and present it upon request by any staff member. Admission into the college premises will be denied without the identity card.
- It is mandatory for students to maintain silence throughout their presence within the college premises and to minimize noise when transitioning between rooms.
- Students are strictly prohibited from lingering in verandas, campus areas, or around classrooms during operational hours.
- Smoking, cycling, and the use of cell phones within the college campus are explicitly forbidden.
- Any form of scrubbing on blackboards or walls is strictly prohibited and subject to disciplinary action.
- Upon the teacher's entry into the classroom, students are expected to stand and remain so until directed to sit or until the teacher is seated.
- Students are expected to display grace and courtesy towards all staff members and are encouraged to greet them whenever encountering them.
- No student is permitted to leave the classroom without the explicit permission of their teacher or until class is officially dismissed for administrative purposes.
- Students without scheduled classes during a specific period are not to disrupt other classes in progress. They are advised to utilize their time by either visiting the library, reading room, or engaging in activities at the playground after 4.30 p.m.
- Any student who disrupts a lesson or engages in misbehavior within a class may be dismissed from the session by the lecturer. Such students will be recorded as absent for that period, and all instances will be reported to the Principal.
